- 1 Courage Center St. Croix opens in 1988, expanding services to the East Metro to address the community's critical needs.
- 2 Served over 20,000 adults and children with disabilities and special needs.
- 3 Recorded nearly 1 million therapeutic pool visits.
- 4 Developed and implemented a comprehensive continuum of care for all clients.
- 5 Provided over 300,000 hours of therapy services.
- 6 Spearheaded a 22-year partnership with Stillwater Public Schools to serve children and adults with special needs in the community.
- 7 Grew from six to over 50 "best in the business" skilled and caring staff.
- 8 Maintained strong staff retention with four of the original six employees still employed at Courage Center St. Croix.

- 13 Developed recreational golf program for adults and children.
- 14 Built collaborative programming with more than 15 local agencies.
- 15 Received the 2000 "Best in Aquatics Award for Special Populations" from Aquatics International.
- 16 Benefited from more than 162,000 hours of volunteers support provided by more than 950 volunteers.
- 17 Completed a 12,000 square foot addition to the facility in 1996 to better serve clients.
- 18 In 1990, added vocational rehab services to help clients re-enter the work force.
- 19 Received 2,857 car donations at Courage Center St. Croix for a total of \$1,560,838 raised.
