This tournament will determine which two teams will advance to the National Tournament June 19-21, 2009 in Fishers, IN.

What is Power Soccer?

Power Soccer is a growing sport, both nationally and internationally with over 50 teams throughout the United States. It is a competitive team sport designed and developed specifically for power wheelchairs and is played by athletes of all ages with various disabilities.

Power Soccer combines the skill of the wheelchair user, speed (6.2 mph) and power of the chair to create an extremely challenging game similar to soccer. Four players make up a team, whose wheelchairs are equipped with front-mounted metal guards. These are used to attack, defend and spin-kick a 13-inch soccer ball in an attempt to score goals. The game is played in a gymnasium on a regulation basketball court.
